66TH IAEA GENERAL CONFERENCE

- 1.1. The delegation of the United Republic of Tanzania (URT) participated in the 66th General Conference of the IAEA which took place at the Vienna International Centre, Vienna, Austria from 26th to 30th September 2022. The Conference was attended by representatives from the IAEA's Member States and other international organizations. Currently IAEA has 173 member states. The conference considered the IAEA's programmes, activities, and its budget for the year 2023. Furthermore, the meeting reviewed the previous year's performance.
- 1.2. In parallel with the General Conference session, the United Republic of Tanzania delegation had series of side meetings on different topics of nuclear science and technology. The delegation was led by Prof James E. Mdoe, Deputy Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, Science and Technology and Hon, Celestine Mushi, Ambassador and permanent Representative as an alternate head.

On Wednesday 28th September 2022, Head of Delegation, Deputy Permanent Secretary, Prof James E. Mdoe delivered the country statement to the 66th IAEA General Conference. These efforts have further strengthened the partnership and cooperation with the Agency. The cooperation has resulted to various improvements in various sectors including Agriculture, Health, Water, livestock and nuclear science in general.
